

### **OTHER ACTIVITIES WITH A4 MATS**

Put them on the floor and take turns to stand on a number and shout it out.

Throw bean bags to land on numbers.

Throw a die and then go and stand on number shown. (Die shows 1 to 6 but you can cover faces to show whatever you like-even just 1 and 2, so three faces show 1 and three faces show 2)

Use as large visual props in all games, rhyming songs etc.

### **OTHER ACTIVITIES WITH NUMBER CARDS**

Place cards face down and say the number as you take turns to turn it over. Reward with a turn at a game, eg push a sword into "Pop Up Pirate"

Try and play the pair game turning two over at a time and removing them once a pair is found-memory skills. Use only 2 or 3 pairs to start with.

Stick the cards on the stairs/steps and say them as you climb up and down them.

Ask your child to climb the stairs to number 3 and wait. Reward with 3 sweeties
