PAYING WITH MORE THAN THE EXACT AMOUNT

I am not going to worry about calculating change. However it is worth practising paying for items with, for example £5, when they are priced for £4.80 etc.

ACTIVITIES

1. Set out £5, £10, £20 only from R14.2 and R14.2. Using items from section 14 activity 3 price them for amounts such as £14, £17, £8, £4, £11 and nllask them to pay for them an item at a time. For example the DVD is priced at £16 and they need to give you £20 and you give them £4 change. If they give you £10 explain using Numicon, a number line and R14.7 that this not enough, 16 is more than 10 and so we need an amount bigger than 10.
