

EARLY DEVELOPMENT GROUPS With Laura, Mel & Wendy

Groups run fortnightly on weekdays for children with Down syndrome aged 12 months to 5/6 years of age. New babies are offered a home visit and are invited to join in the second half of the youngest group. The early intervention covers early reading, number, feeding, drinking, interaction, communication, language, speech sounds, fine and gross motor skills. Our aim is to prepare the children for school. Older groups (children aged 5 to 6) run monthly and school staff are encouraged to attend in place of parents so that we can pass on methods of best practice. Several children with more complex needs receive one to one input. All staff are qualified and very experienced teachers and can offer support and guidance to your child's school.



TRAINING AT OUR CENTRE IN BINGLEY

ME: my body, my friends, my life

(Sexuality relationships education for people with Down syndrome and other learning disabilities)

How to teach children & young people with Down syndrome about their bodies, keeping safe, privacy, social boundaries and self help skills.

This training is over two full days. The first part of this was delivered in November 2024 but due to Wendy's accident the second part was postponed.

We have decided to rerun the full course in April 2025.

Session 1, Wednesday 23rd April, 9.30 to 3pm

Session 2, Wednesday 30th April, 9.30 to 3pm

This course covers:

- How important such training is for young people with learning disabilities.
- Names for body parts. Privacy.
- Puberty for girls, puberty for boys,
- Feelings, personal hygiene, self help skills.
- Touching, hugging, affection, friendships.
- Safety in the community. Assertiveness. Abuse prevention strategies. How do we become our own protector?

- primary school to secondary school
- middle school to secondary school, or
- secondary school to a post-16 institution.
