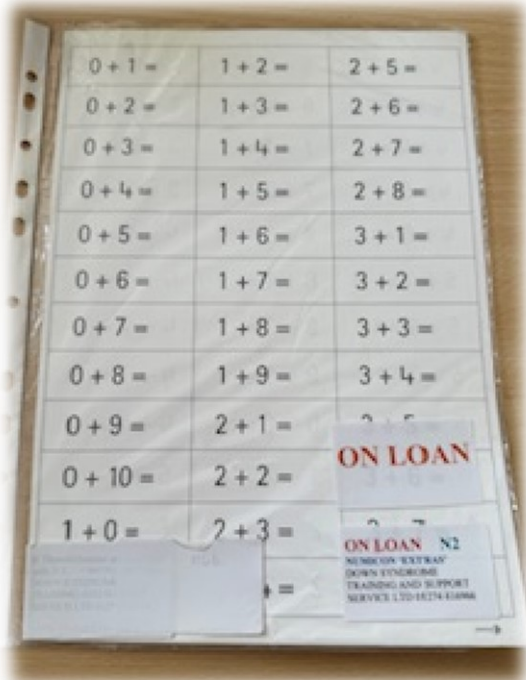

Contains Numicon post box, spinner and overlays, sum sheets and a set of 1-10 Numicon picture cards.

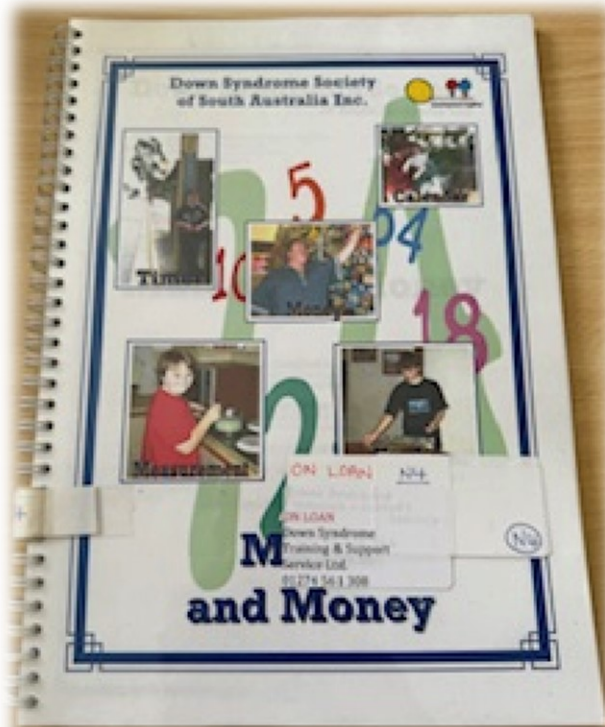


N3: Numicon Home Kit

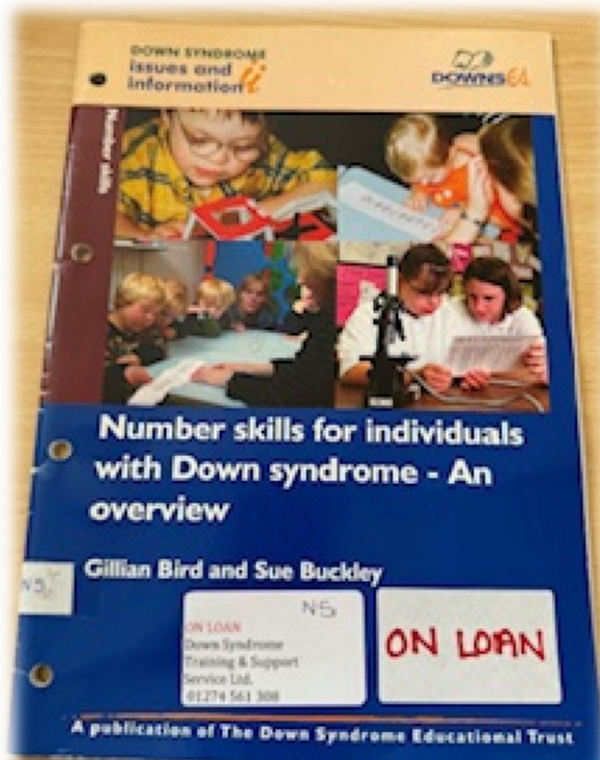
This kit contains Numicon shapes, pegs, boards, and activity cards. They provide our children with a visual representation of numbers. Learning numbers using the

A booklet produced by the Down Syndrome Society South Australia outlining programmes and strategies for teaching space, number, money, and measurement.

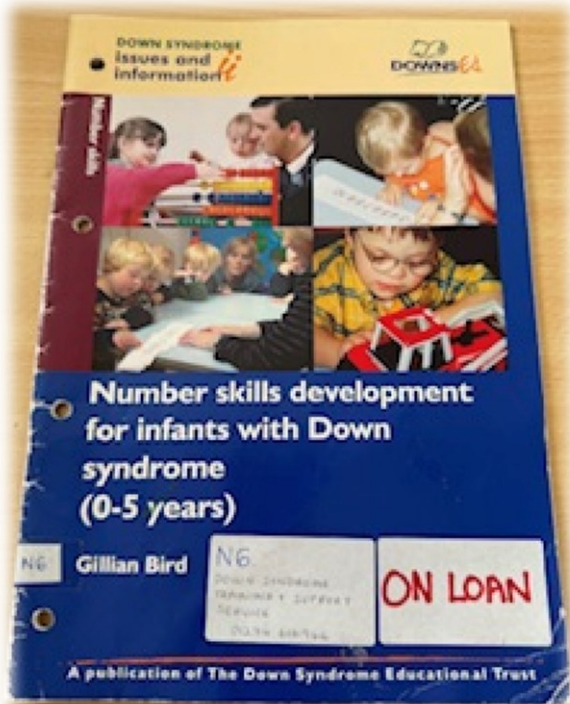


N5: Number Skills for People with Down Syndrome - An Overview

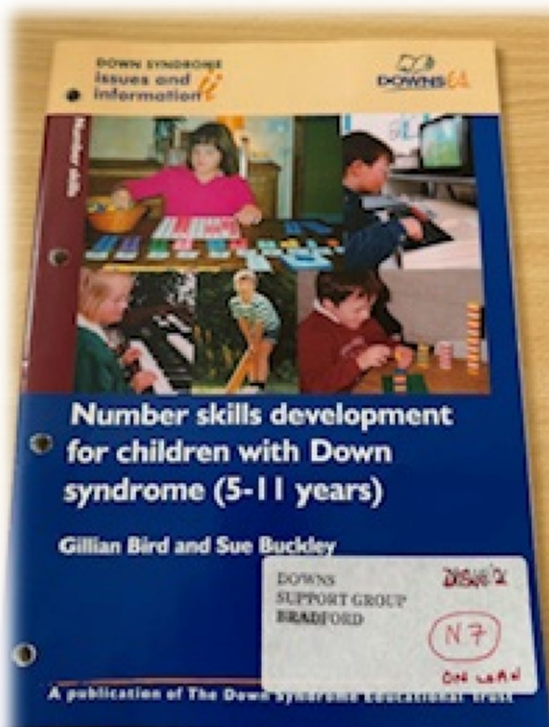


N6: Number Skills Development for Infants with Down Syndrome (0-5 Years)

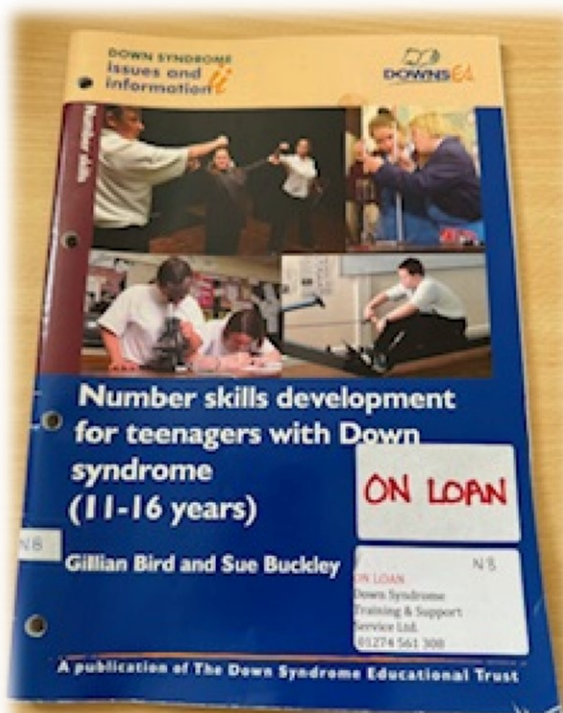

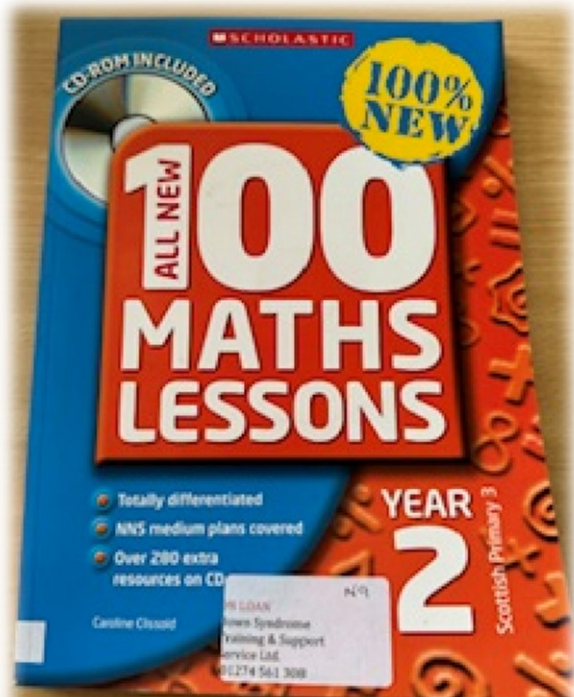


N8: Number Skills Development for Teenagers with Down Syndrome (11-16 Years)

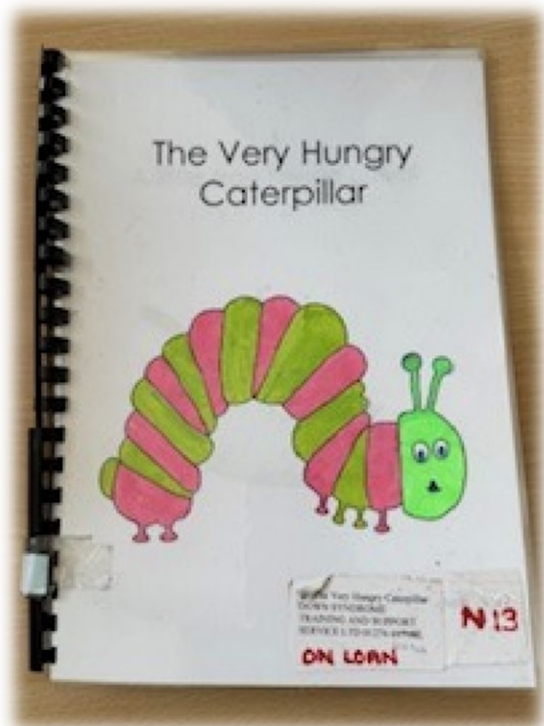

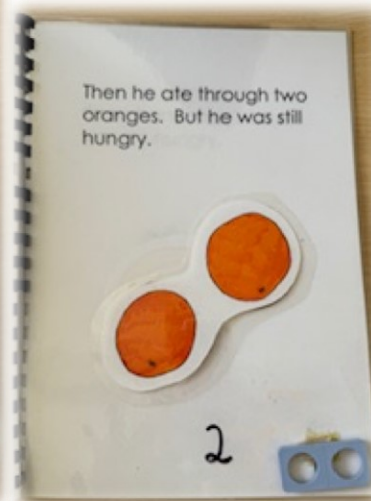

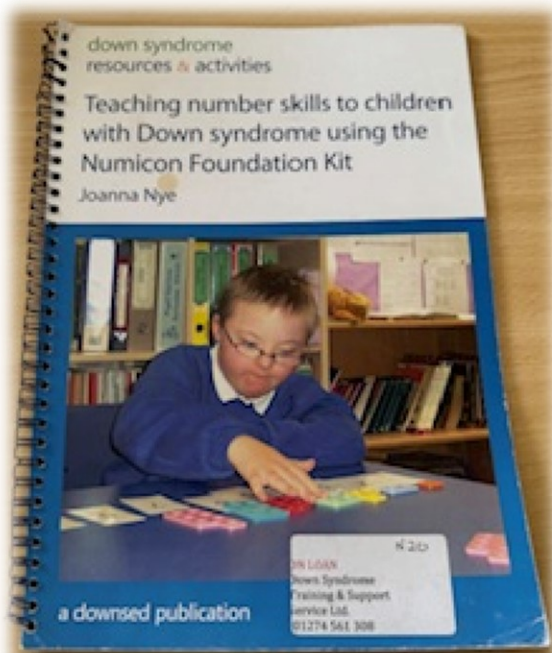
