SECTION 11

MAKING AMOUNTS WITH 2 COINS BELOW £1 AND POUND COINS.

This section will also use resources from section 6. These may be revised before this section and used alongside if needed.

ACTIVITIES

- 1. Using cards from R11.1 and the "1" card from R11.2 and the grid from R10.1 place the 1 card on the £ side and the cards from R11.2 face down under the pence side. Take turns to turn over a card from this pile to generate an amount, eg £1.51. Have the coins set out on the table rather than in a purse or wallet so that the child can select the correct 3 coins and place them under the correct headings. Use resources form section 6 to help check the pence amount is correct if needed. Keep going until all the pence cards have been used. When using 03, 04, 06 and 07 discuss how this is NOT the same as 30, 40, 60, 70. If struggling get out 3 Numicon ten shapes to make 30, then match 03 to the Numicon 3 shape etc.
- 2. Play the game as above but also use cards 0 to 4 from R11.2 face down in a pile under the £ heading and turn over a card from each pile to generate a pound amount, eg £3.25.
- 3. Play shopping games with these amounts. If struggling with 51p, 15p etc make sure you have the Numicon coins to hand and the resources from R3.1.
